## The Opportunity

CreativeHub 1352 is seeking workshop submissions for Summer Arts Mississauga.

We will select a variety of mediums, materials and themes that will foster creative expression and experimentation. Instructors can choose to facilitate indoor or outdoor programming, for example, drawing from live fauna and flora outside or gathering materials for basket weaving from the surrounding environment.

Successful applicants will commit to leading their single session workshop as a one-off or be selected for recurring sessions. Workshops can be catered towards children, youth, seniors, and adults, with a timeframe ranging from 2hrs - 4hrs in length.

Notification of Acceptance: March 15

All programs will be scheduled between 10:00am-4:00pm.

## Location

The outdoor workshops will be held at the Small Arms Inspection Building, located at 1352 Lakeshore Rd. East in Mississauga within walking distance of Long Branch GO train, and Toronto and Mississauga bus transit. Indoor workshops will be held at various City of Mississauga recreation buildings, TBC.

## Eligibility

Applications are open to individual artists and makers, artist collectives, educational organizations, groups, and not-for-profit or charitable organizations operating in Ontario and Canada.

## Budget

Instructor fees are to be negotiated; proposed fees should include hourly instructor rate and workshop materials cost. All materials, tools and equipment must be provided by the instructor.

# Workshop Information

- Single session one-off or recurring workshops, no multi-session programming
- Ideally designed for beginners
- Minimum workshop length of 2 hours, maximum 4 hrs
- Maximum capacity of 20 participants

- **Visual Support Material:** Please include 3-5 images to supplement your proposal, specifically showing the completed workshop product. These can also include images of your proposed materials, past work, etc.
- **Visual Support Material List:** Please include a short list describing the Visual Support Materials.
